CALL FOR NOMINATION FOR THE APPOINTMENT OF COUNCIL MEMBER AT THE WESTERN CAPE COLLEGE OF NURSING (WCCN)

The Minister of Health and Wellness- Provincial Government of Western Cape invites members of public to nominate a person for the appointment to serve as a member of the Western Cape College of Nursing (WCCN) Council in terms of section 4 of the WCCN Institutional Statute. The Western Cape College of Nursing have three campuses across the province namely, Boland Overberg Nursing Campus in Worcester, Southern Cape Karoo Nursing Campus in George and Metro Nursing Campus in Athlone, Cape Town.

Number of Positions available: Two (2)

The nominees must be suitably qualified and with expertise in the following areas:

- **Finance (1) • Clinical Experience in Nursing Education & Training (1)**

Successful candidates shall be appointed to fill the existing vacancies within the WCCN Council. The person to be appointed shall serve as a Council Member for the office term of four (4) years.

- a) The Nominees must not be employees of the Western Cape Government Health and Wellness and / or Western Cape College of Nursing (WCCN).
- b) Remuneration: • Sitting allowance as per the tariffs approved by the Western Cape Government: Department of Health and Wellness. All travelling expenses will be paid by the college as per the Department of Transport tariffs.

Knowledge, skills and experience: • Knowledge of the Higher Education and Training Sector • Knowledge and understanding of the functioning of public colleges • Nominee must have several years' experience in the field of Finance and Clinical Experience in Nursing Education & Training • Nominees with Public Sector experience or those who have served on any council (including but not limited to Higher Education Institutions) will have an added advantage.
